Welcome new and returning students. We are excited that another dance season is underway.

Please mark your calendars. The recital is scheduled for Sunday, June 7 at the Perry Park Center Theater.

We will begin measuring students for their costumes in November. **There is a \$55 costume deposit due per costume by Thursday, December 5.** Costumes will be ordered Friday, December 6. If you have not paid your costume deposit, a costume will not be ordered for your dancer. There may be a small balance due in January if the costume cost is greater than \$55.00. Tights are included with costume. You can make your costume deposits any time. Costume deposits received after December 5 will result in a \$20 shipping fee added to the cost of the costume as it will be ordered separately from the costumes ordered on December 6.

We do not prorate tuition for missed classes due to illness, inclement weather or holiday closings. Tuition not paid within the month it is due will result in a \$30 late fee. If tuition and late fee are not paid by the 5th of the following month, classes will be terminated due to non payment of tuition. Please make sure you pay your tuition on time. Cash and check is accepted in the studio or you may pay your accounts online using credit or debit.

Please do not bring food or drinks other than water into the studio. Students with multiple classes may bring a snack.

Discounted tickets are available for the Moscow Ballet Nutcracker performances on December 9th and 10th. Order forms are in the office. Payment is made to the Moscow Ballet but forms need to be turned in to the office. Once we receive the tickets we will let you know and you can pick them up in the office.

The studio will be closed on Thursday, October 31 so that dancers may participate in Halloween activities if they wish to do so.
